Subject: Protocol modifying the “Headquarters Agreement between the Government of the Argentine Republic and the International Criminal Police Organization – INTERPOL regarding a Sub-Regional Bureau for South America”

The ICPO-INTERPOL General Assembly, meeting in Monaco from 3 to 7 November 2014 at its 83rd session:

HAVING REGARD TO Articles 8, 30 and 31 of the Organization’s Constitution,

HAVING EXAMINED Report AG-2014-RAP-13 on the Protocol modifying the “Headquarters Agreement between the Government of the Argentine Republic and the International Criminal Police Organization –INTERPOL regarding a Sub-Regional Bureau for South America”,

RECALLING that, in the discharge of their functions, the Organization and its bodies need the active cooperation and assistance of INTERPOL Members,
